It was great to see our community come together to help Terina. And, of course, it wouldn't have happened without people like you!

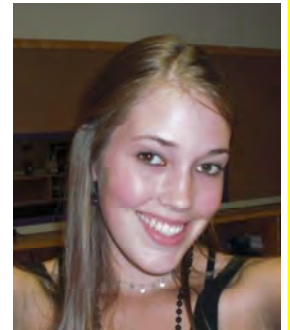
